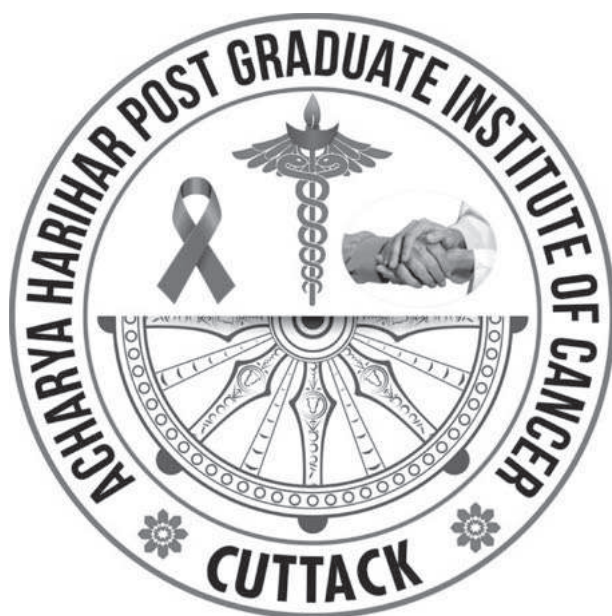

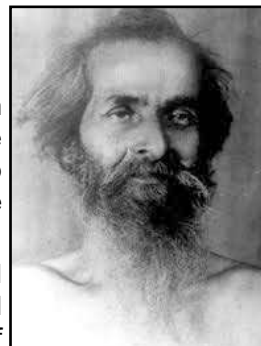

ACHARYA HARIHARA

An Illustrious Personality

Acharya Harihara Das, one of the leading soldiers of the freedom struggle of India, was born to Mahadeb Brahma and Sradhadevi of Sri Ram Chandrapur of Sakhigopal in Puri district in 1869. His educational career began with the village Chahali and the middle vernacular school after which he joined the Puri Zilla School with a scholarship from the government to complete the entrance examination. He did his F.A. from the Ravenshaw College.



Non-acceptance of others belongings is a lesson he imbibed from his childhood and followed. From his early childhood Acharya Harihar was dedicated towards social service. He had laid the foundation stone of an associated social service in the land of Odisha. He united the student forum and youth for service to the needy and downtrodden. The childhood friendship with Gopabandhu, Nilakantha, Krupasindhu and Ananta matured at Ravenshaw College. Being bound by self-resolution, Harihara accepted the invitation to join as teacher in Nilgiri School, then Ravenshaw Collegiate School and finally Pyari Mohan Academy at Cuttack. He took the challenge to confront the unruly boys in the school and innovated a novel technique to set them right. He visited their houses, watched their movements and established a cordial relationship with their parents offering the scope to teach the boys freely. This changed the chemistry between them. He never punished the boys for their faults rather explained them convincingly till they admitted their faults.

How to liberate India from the British-Yoke was the sole thought from his childhood which he tried to translate into action by creating people of extraordinary caliber who could face all the grim situations heroically. He left Pyari Mohan Academy to join the Satyabadi Open Air School which was to be conducted in the green verdant trees of vakulaand chhuriana at Sakhigopal. Virtually, the school was the brainchild of Utkalmani Gopabandhu Das and Acharya Harihar. As a Superintendent of the hostel, he became popular among 4 the students. Though students referred to other teachers as Pundit, Harihara was referred to as Acharya and was a great favourite with the students. The basic objective of Satyabadi School was to inculcate the sense of nationalism among the masses by uniting all, irrespective of caste, creed and religion. The decline of Satyabadi School did not cast any negative impact on him rather he cheerfully accepted Gopabandhus proposal to work for one Bidhaba Ashrama at Puri. The young widows were brought to this ashram where all sorts of care like education, for moral and mental development was extended by Acharya Harihara. When Gopbandhu was imprisoned, he became the editor of The Samaj and kept the paper afloat as a medium of socio-political awareness in Orissa. He also managed the Swaraj Ashram at Cuttack.

The clarion call of Mahatma Gandhi to carryout Salt-Satyagraha in 1930 created a stir in the nook and corner of India. Acharya Harihar led the procession to Inchudi receiving welcome from village to village till arrival at the destination. He was arrested there by the police and spent six months at Hazaribagjail in Bihar. There he spent much of his time to spread messages against the British rule. He was a true disciple of Gandhiji who sincerely worked for attaining freedom of India.

He was elected unanimously as the president of Provincial Congress Committee after the Orissa Province came into existence.

Acharya Harihara and other freedom fighters were arrested and put to jail. Acharya taught these fellows inside the jail. Here Acharya Harihara took food just for sustenance and translated Bhagabat Gita. He was released from jail in the year 1944. He became an active member of Bhoodan Movement and accompanied Vinobajee from village to village in the year 1955. Presiding over the 12th Annual Conference of Sarvodaya Sammilani held at Sevagram on 26th March, 1960 he told, Freedom has come. But it does not reach the village. The sunrises in the east. But does not find the bright sunrays as we close our doors. The great soul did unceasing work for the upliftment of the people of Orissa and passed away on 29th. February, 1971 at 93 years.

REPORT OF THE DEAN AND PRINCIPAL

Acharya Harihar Post Graduate Institute of Cancer (AHPGIC) formerly known as Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre (AHRCC), born in 1984, is now a prominent developing regional cancer centre of Eastern India. Around 90,000 patients are attending the OPD annually out of which around 26,000 patients are admitted to indoor to avail different services from this centre. Out of them around 11% are from KBK districts and 3% are from adjoining states of West Bengal, Jharkhand, Chhatisgarh, Andhra Pradesh. There are 10 different departments in our centre providing diagnostic and therapeutic services like Surgery, Radiotherapy and Chemotherapy. Palliative care and preventive Oncology services are provided to improve the quality of life.



AHPGIC, Cuttack is now a full-fledged post-graduate institute with superspeciality courses. The courses have been approved by Utkal University. Teaching and training programmes of these courses are going on as per MCI guidelines in AHPGIC. The final university examination of first batch of MCh student is being conducted in the month of August, 2020.

During the year 2019 four MCh students - two in Gynaecological Oncology and two in Surgical Oncology have been admitted in the 3rd batch as per the MCI guideline. The following four students selected through NEET superspeciality counselling-2019 had taken admission in the month of September, 2019. They will appear in their university examination in the year 2022.

The PG course in Radiation Oncology has been inherited from SCB Medical College when AHRCC was declared as an autonomous institute in 1984. Now, six PG students are taking admission each year for Radiation Oncology course.

Besides, this year twenty students have taken admission in the 3rd batch in Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) course and continuing their study as per the DMLT Council guideline of Government of Odisha. They will appear in their final examination in the year 2021.

We are planning to open PG courses in the subject of Anaesthesiology, Onco-Pathology, PG Diploma in medical physics and training programmes for medical physics interns and Diploma in Radiotherapy Technician (DRTT) course.

Research is an integral segment of medical education and patient care. We have a regular institutional ethics committee (IEC) under the chairmanship of Dr. Asok Das, Bhubaneswar and Dr. Dillip Kumar Agarwalla as Member Secretary. We are holding meetings at regular intervals.

The PG students are continuing their research for their thesis programme. A research programme sponsored by I.C.M.R is going on with Prof. Sagarika Samantray of Onco-Pathology Department.

The objective of publishing a year book is to compile all academic activities going on in AHPGIC. This will encourage its faculties, PG students, Doctors, Research Scholars, Paramedical workers to improve their academic activities and patient care.

This centre is the first of its kind as post-graduate medical education centre of our state which will help to produce cancer specialist and para-medical workers to fulfill the need of human resources for better patient care in our state as well as the country in the field of Oncology.

For this endeavour, I am grateful to our Director, faculties, residents, doctors, PG students and staffs for their participation and encouragement.

AHPGIC AT A GLANCE

ACADEMICS & RESEARCH

Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre has been recognized as **Acharya Harihar Post Graduate Institute of Cancer, (AHPGIC)** due to its dedication towards cancer research and treatment in 2019-20. Two M.Ch students each in the subject (Gynaecological Oncology and Surgical Oncology), six PG students of Radiation Oncology and Twenty DMLT students have taken admission during the academic year 2019-20. The first batch of internship in medical physics has been completed successfully.

Research is an integral segment of medical education and patient care. Institutional Ethics Committee of the centre conducts meetings at regular intervals for review and approval of new research work to be performed. Several Govt. and industry sponsored intramural and extramural research works are being conducted in the institution resulting in good amount of publications in premier journals of national and international repute.

Library Committee supervises the maintenance and development of AHPGIC central library and e-library. Post graduate committee monitors PG & M.Ch. education as well as inter departmental and inter institutional academic activities.

Hospital Based Cancer Registry & Patterns of Care & Survival Studies in Cancer Cervix, Cancer Breast and Head & Neck Cancers (HBCR-POCSS) project under National Cancer Registry Programme is working in the centre. Similarly the centre is enrolled in National Cancer Grid network. The NCG was created to form a union of cancer centres in the country which could provide uniform and high standards

of cancer care, follow uniform evidence based guidelines for management of patients, develop human resource adequately trained to fulfil the cancer healthcare needs of the entire nation and conduct collaborative clinical research of a high standard.

Tumor board is conducted every day for discussion and decision of treatment protocols for new patients consisting of specialists of each segment.

Collaboration with Tata Trust

Up-gradation of AHPGIC is under process in collaboration with Tata Trust in an effort to advance cancer care in the state.

NIRAMAYA

The new drug ware house is functioning for storing and management of Anticancer drugs for the whole state and NIRAMAYA is able to fulfil 100% demand for both general and anticancer drugs.

Telemedicine

Telemedicine centre is a great help for cancer patients of different districts minimizing the long distance travel to the centre. This is also being utilized for teleconferencing with premier institutes for academic discussions and meetings. This service became the best support for the patients during the lock down due to Covid-19 pandemic outbreak.

Community Activity

AHPGIC is actively engaged in the community service in the form of cancer education, consultation and early detection through camps and various media across the state.

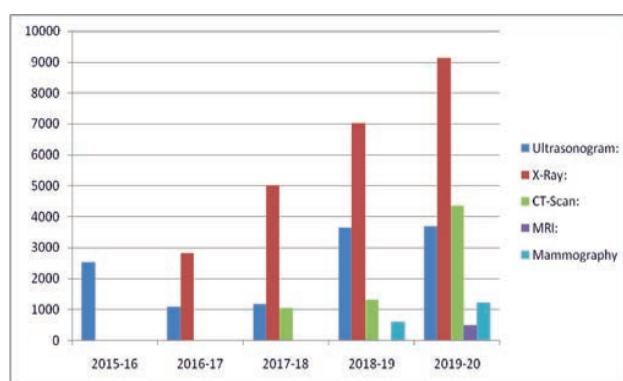
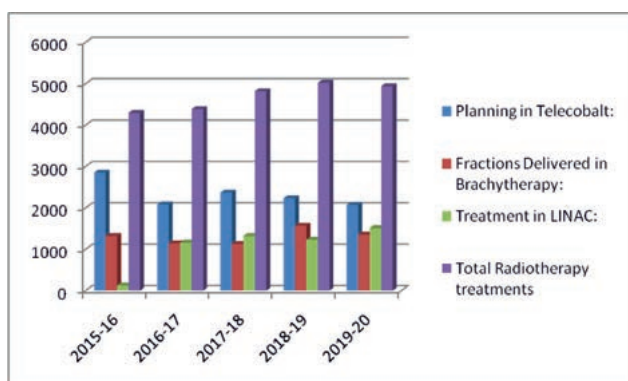
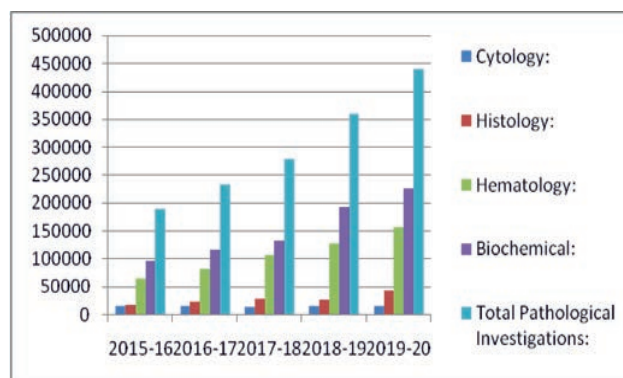
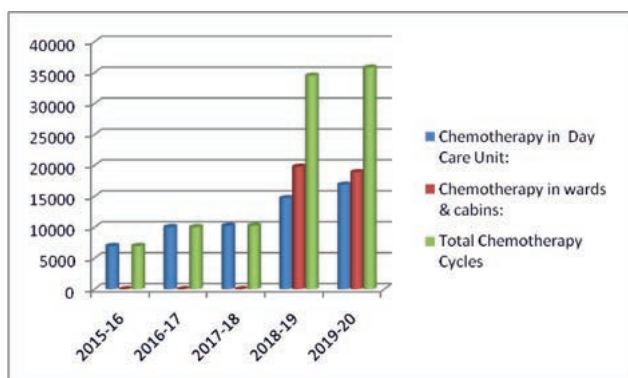
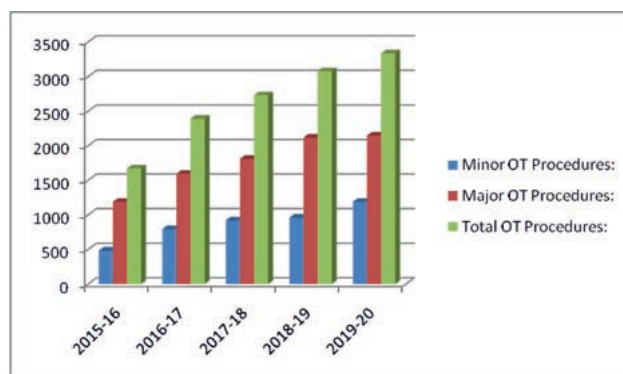
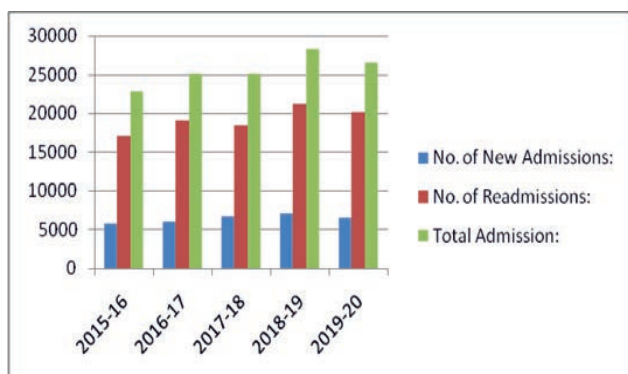
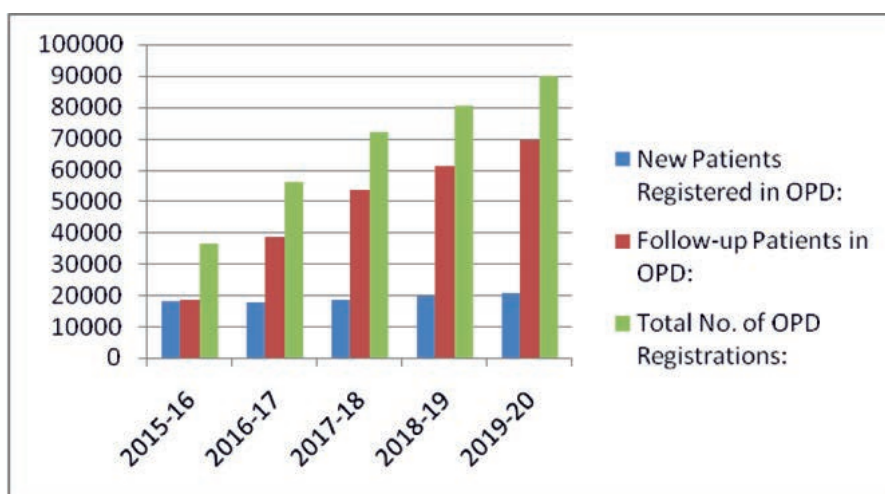
- Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre has been officially renamed as Acharya Harihar Post Graduate Institute of Cancer (AHPGIC).

This unit provides prompt pain relief and palliative care through different modalities of services & immediate management of pain to patients at any stage of the disease (mostly terminally ill) with an intention for an improved quality of life. The services provided here have managed to garner recognition throughout different modalities of services & immediate management of pain to patients at any stage of the disease (mostly terminally ill) with an intention for an improved quality of life. The services provided here have managed to garner recognition throughout the region which is reflected through the influx of patients from various government and private medical colleges & hospitals of eastern India. IAPC certification courses are being conducted in 2 sessions in a year for all doctors, nurses, volunteers and social workers at the centre.

Our centre, being the State Nodal Centre for Palliative Care, coordinates with the 30 satellite centres established at district headquarter hospitals of the state, to offer Palliative treatment.

There is a plan to strengthen this department by creating separate faculty post, thereby opening PG course in Palliative Medicine.

- 60 Doctors & Nurses from 30 Districts of Odisha had a 2 days of Class room teaching at NABM & One day Hands on Training at AHPGIC regarding Pain and Palliative Care treatment for cancer patients.

- A sixteen hours volunteers programme in Palliative Care at the Theosophical Society, Cuttack on 14th March 2019 in collaboration with IAPC was Conducted and a group of 75 participants were trained to address physical, psychological, Social and Spiritual needs of terminally ill Patients by Dr. Sumita Mohanty.

- 30 Home care Nurses under OSDA have undergone Training in Pain Palliative Care Unit from 16th August to 5th Sept 2019 (A group of 10 over five days period)

HEAD & NECK ONCOLOGY

Oral cancer is one of the 10 most common cancers of the world and the commonest in India. There is excellent evidence from many sources that approximately 90% of these cancers are due to tobacco abuse in any form and poor oral & dental hygiene. Almost 70% - 80% of the cases reported have advanced stage of cancer which is practically in Stage-III & IV. Cancers of the Thyroid gland, parotid gland and minor salivary glands are also frequently reported in this Dept. The incidence of pre-malignant lesions like leukoplakia and sub-mucous fibrosis has increased considerably. Cosmetic value being a vital factor, various reconstructive procedures are being performed by this department. The post-graduate students, Paramedical staffs and ex-service doctors are imparted regular training programs keeping in view the early detection,

prevention and treatment of Head & Neck cancers as the main theme.

MEDICAL PHYSICS

The Department of Medical Physics ensures implementation of the provisions of the Radiation Protection Rules (RPR)-2004 enforced by the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB), Government of India with the following responsibilities:

- Evaluation and optimization of Radiation treatment planning for cancer patients undergoing radiation therapy.
- Performing radiation dosimetry, periodic calibrations, quality assurance (QA) testing traceable to national standards laboratory and maintenance of all the radiotherapeutic and radio-diagnostic equipments / machines.

- Observing radiation safety for the radiation workers, staff members, patients and public in the Departments of Radiation Oncology, Radiodiagnosis, Nuclear Medicine and Medical Physics.
- Participating in various research and developmental activities of the centre.
- Facility design and Planning for commissioning of new radiation installations and decommissioning of old installations in accordance with the requirements of the installation that meets the regulatory stipulations of radiation protection and safety.
- Preparations of specifications for treatment and dosimetric equipment;
- Acceptance testing, commissioning and quality assurance (including calibration) of radiation facilities.
- Measurement, analysis and tabulation of beam data for clinical use.
- Development of Q A protocols and procedures in radiation therapy regarding delivery of radiation treatment, radiation safety and control and regulatory supervision of radiation therapy equipment servicing and maintenance of records.
- Teaching Radiation Physics to the PG students for MD (Radiation Oncology) degree and the DMRT(Dip. in Medical Radiation Technology) students of SCB Medical College, Cuttack.

RADIATION ONCOLOGY

This department treats about 200 patients daily using telecobalt therapy and HDR brachytherapy. About 65% of all cancer patients attending this institute avail radiation therapy during their course of treatment. External Beam therapy is delivered by one telecobalt units (Theratron-780C) from 8:00 AM to late night in three shifts on all working days. Multiple-fields, wedge, block and tangential fields at 80cm SSD

are practiced as required. Now the department is well equipped with Linear Accelerator and CTSimulator. More than thousand patients were treated successfully with most sophisticated treatment modalities like VMAT and IMRT. PG-studies in radiotherapy leading to MD (RT) is available in the institute since 1973. Six PG students admit every year for their MD degree. Post graduate seminars are organized twice a month.

SURGICAL ONCOLOGY

Surgical oncology is one of the important departments of the cancer centre. Usually all the new patients coming to the center are first seen in the Surgical Oncology OPD and after getting the tissue or cytological diagnosis and evaluation for operability both clinically and radiologically, those patients are taken for surgical admission and operations. Inoperable cases detected either clinically or radiologically are referred for other modality of treatments like chemotherapy and or radiotherapy.

Modified radical mastectomy, Breast conservation surgeries, radical gastric resections, Abdomino Perineal Resection of rectal cancers are few of those surgeries being done routinely. Radical as well as conservative surgeries for cancer penis are also done frequently. Many a times palliative and bypass surgeries are being done to alleviate pain and agony, Oesophago-gastrectomy, Whipples procedures are been done less frequently. Wide local excision of soft tissue cancers are also being done in routine basis along with Reconstructive procedures. One reconstructive surgeon is working full time but on deputation basis from civil hospital. A fulltime faculty in plastic and reconstructive surgery is badly needed for this department. Post-graduate students from the department of Surgery, SCB Medical College, Cuttack are undertaking training on rotation, They are getting much better exposure and benefit as more than 50% of cases in their examination period are oncology subject. We need to get more and more support from the HOD Surgery from SCB Medical college in this regard posting them on rotation and also for at least 3 months instead of 1 month. Surgeons from peripheral health services are also undergoing re-orientation training in surgical technique on rotation basis. This reorientation program for the peripheral surgeons needs to be on a more regular basis which is not the fact now. The departmental seminar is being conducted regularly. The faculties have also



delivered many guest lecturers, presented papers in conferences and taken part in various symposia and workshops. Faculties have regularly taking part in early cancer detection and educational programs joining the cancer control camps and various awareness programs. M.Ch. in Surgical Oncology is continuing from 2017.

BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The month of October is celebrated worldwide for Breast Cancer Awareness and AHPGIC, Cuttack joined hands with all enthusiasm in the global event on October 12th 2019. A Breast Cancer Awareness Programme and Screening Mammogram were held in AHPGIC, Cuttack in the OPD Block with the theme.

From Screening to Survival: An AHPGIC Initiative.

Several dignitaries like the Secretary, Cuttack Municipal Corporation Mrs Ananya Das, Inner Wheel President Mrs Gayatree Das, Advocate Odisha High Court & Supreme Court Mr Abhijit Pattnaik, Rajyogini Prajapita Brahmakumari BK Saral, Editor Orissa Medical Journal & Senior Psychiatrist Dr. Samrat Kar,

Secretary Odisha Youth Journalist Mr Deepesh Mohapatra graced the occasion.

The event was presided by Dr Lalatendu Sarangi, Director, AHPGIC, Cuttack who welcomed the august gathering in a background of pink ribbons and balloons, aptly suiting the occasion in the OPD Block of AHPGIC. The target population for the event were selected members of the Inner Wheel Association, Cuttack, members of Prajapita Brahmakumari, Cuttack and Dhenkanal, members of Jain Community, Choudhury Bazaar, and others from various parts of Cuttack.

Prior to organising the event, the target population was sensitised about the requirement of Screening Mammogram and only those with high risk factors like positive family history, age above 40 years, obesity, history of other benign conditions of the breast were selected for Screening Mammogram in the Dept of Radiology, AHPGIC, Cuttack.

More than 100 females participated in the Awareness Programme and 58 of them underwent Mammogram. Reporting was done as per BIRADS Score (Breast Imaging Reporting and Data System). Twenty two females had BIRADS 1, twenty nine had BIRADS 2, six had BIRADS 3 and one had BIRADS 4 Score. Those with BIRADS 3 and 4 were further called for USG of breast the next week and the one with BIRADS 4 was advised biopsy of the breast mass.

Various faculties of AHPGIC delivered lectures on the risk factors of breast cancer, early detection, techniques of breast self examination and the importance of Mammogram in detecting breast cancer. Prof Padmalaya Devi, Surgical Oncology & Superintendent, AHPGIC delivered a lecture on the theme From Screening to Survival.

Dr. Suvendu Mohapatra, Assistant Professor, Radiology, AHPGIC reported the Mammograms and Dr Lucy Pattanayak, Associate Professor, Radiation Oncology was the Programme Co-ordinator.

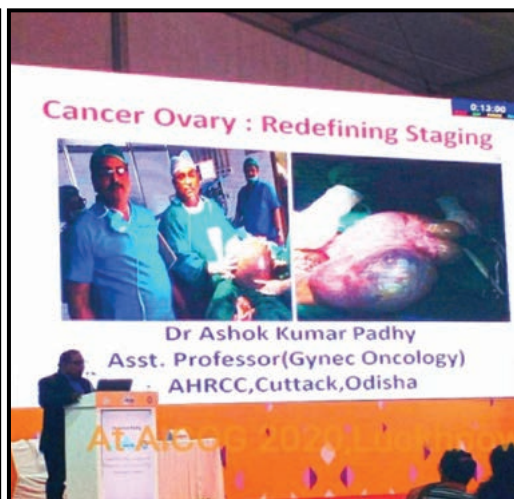
