TENDER CALL NOTICE

Sealed tenders in two-bid system are invited from intending manufacturers/authorized agents/dealers for refilling of medicinal gases (oxygen, nitrous oxide, and carbon dioxide) in various types of cylinders and repair of defective cylinders for a period of two years only from the date of approval. The tenders should reach the office of the undersigned by 08.04.2024 at 5 PM through Registered Post/Speed Post only, which will be opened on 09.04.2024 at 12.30 PM in the office chamber of the Director, AHPGIC, Cuttack. The date of pre-bid meeting is fixed on 22.03.2024 at 12.30 PM.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The tenderers shall submit the tenders with **Technical Bid** and **Price Bid** in two separate sealed envelopes superscribed as Technical Bid (Cover-A) and Price Bid (Cover-B) in respective envelopes. Both Cover-A and Cover-B sealed envelopes should be kept in a big envelope superscribed as **Tender for Refilling of Medicinal Gases** and sent by Regd. Post/Speed Post only addressed to The Director, Acharya Harihar Post Graduate Institute of Cancer, Mangalabag, Cuttack-753007.
2. Sealed tenders must be accompanied by an EMD worth **Rs. 20,000/-** (refundable) only in the shape of DD drawn in favour of **The Director, Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre, Cuttack**, which should be kept in Cover-A.
3. The tenderer shall submit up-to-date valid license for manufacture and sale of medicinal gases (Cover-A).
4. The authorized agents must submit the certificate of authorization from the manufacturer for storage and supply of medicinal gases (Cover-A).
5. The tenderers must submit the attested Xerox copy of PAN Card in the name of the agency and GST Registration Certificate.
6. The tenderers should furnish the rate per cubic meter of oxygen, per kg of carbon dioxide, and 1000 lit. of nitrous oxide separately including loading, unloading, and transportation charges of empty and gas-filled cylinders to and fro from the firm concerned and this hospital in the price bid (Cover-B).
7. The L1 bidder for oxygen shall be the L1 bidder for CO<sub>2</sub> , NO<sub>2</sub> & accessories by default.
8. **Quality of gas**
  - (a) Oxygen:- Minimum purity- 99% as per I.P.
  - (b) Nitrous oxide:- Minimum purity- 98% as per I.P.
  - (c) Carbon dioxide:- Minimum purity- 99% as per I.S.I.



9. Quantity of gas

(a) Oxygen:- Settle pressure- minimum 140 kg/cm<sup>2</sup>

(b) Nitrous oxide:- Minimum weight- 29 kg. Weight of full cylinder- Tare weight punched on cylinder neck.

(c) Carbon dioxide:- Weight of full cylinder- Tare weight punched on cylinder neck.

10. The transaction of business shall be made purely on credit basis. No advance payment will be made against execution of order. Refilled cylinders will be received through challan throughout the month and a single bill in triplicate is to be generated and produced at the end of each month mentioning the no. of variety of cylinders as well as the cost of total quantities of gases supplied during this period to facilitate payment. The authority will not be liable for delay in payment in an unavoidable circumstance like paucity of funds, etc.

11. Hydraulic testing and repair of defective cylinders shall be done by the tenderers free of cost.

12. Rate per new valve, if fitted during repair must be clearly mentioned and the rejected valves must be returned to the undersigned. No cylinder will be kept pending at the firm neither officially or unofficially for repair. Only a fixed no. of repaired cylinders will be kept with the firm at one time, which may be replaced by the defective ones each time so that the no. of empty cylinders sent to the firm will be the same as the no. of full cylinders received in order to maintain smooth statistics. The no. of defective valves will be taken into account after receiving the same physically and cylinders to which the new valves are fitted must be shown.

13. The tenderers must ensure and give an undertaking for uninterrupted supply of all the said gases within 24 hours of deposit of empty cylinders (in Cover-A). The prices quoted in the price bid shall be valid throughout the tender period and no request for hike in prices within the tender validity period shall be entertained.

14. The tenderers or their authorized representative may remain present at the time of opening of the tenders. However, their absence shall not be a constraint in opening of tenders.

15. Tenders received beyond scheduled date and time and via any other method other than as specified above shall not be entertained and will be rejected outright. Original documents shall be produced for verification if asked for.

16. The tenderers qualified after opening of the technical bid (Cover-A) shall be called for opening of price bids (Cover-B) the date and time of which shall be intimated to the qualified bidders.

17. EMDs of the bidders shall remain with the undersigned till finalization of the tender process and shall be returned to the bidders without interest after award of tender as soon as possible.

18. If any information/documents furnished by the tenderers with the tender paper are found to be misleading or incorrect at any stage, their tenders will be cancelled and the said tenderers shall be barred from taking part in any further tender process in subsequent years.

19. DD towards purchase of tender paper amounting to **Rs. 2000.00** (non-refundable) is to be enclosed in the technical bid (Cover-A).




20. The successful tenderer shall submit performance security in the shape of Bank Guarantee worth **Rs. 40,000/-** for two years pledged in favour of **The Director, Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre, Cuttack**. After expiry of the tender validity period, the same shall be returned without interest. Any discrepancy in supply of medicinal gases shall be considered breach of contract and the penalty shall be realized from the Bank Guarantee.

21. The bidder shall furnish turnover certificate in respect of yearly turnover of preceding 3 (three) successive years, which should not be less than Rs. 1 crore per annum from a chartered accountant firm.

22. The tenderers shall give an undertaking that they have generator facility or any alternative arrangement for refilling of gas cylinders even during power failure to maintain uninterrupted supply of medicinal gases.

23. The validity of tender shall remain in force for a period of two years only from the date of approval.

24. The undersigned reserves the full right to accept in full or part or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
