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## **TENDER CALL NOTICE**

Sealed tenders in two-bid system are invited from intending manufacturers/distributors/stockist/retailers for supply of medicines and medical consumables items in bulk quantity to the undersigned as per requirement of the hospital, which will be valid for a period of one year from the date of approval. The tenders should reach the office of the undersigned by 5 PM on 19.06.2025 through Registered Post/Speed Post only, which will be opened on 20.06.2025 at 12.30 PM in the office chamber of the Director, AHPGIC, Cuttack. Last date & time of receipt of pre-bid queries through mail (ahrccdirector@gmail.com/ntstore.ahrcc.2019@gmail.com) is fixed on 2.06.2025 at 4.00 PM. Queries submitted on the pre-bid date shall not be entertained under any circumstances. The date of pre-bid meeting has been fixed on 3.06.2025 at 12.30 PM.

#### **DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED IN TECHNICAL BID**

- 1. The tenderers shall submit the tender documents with technical bid in sealed cover superscribed as "technical bid (Cover-A)" and price bid in sealed cover superscribed as "price bid (Cover-B)," which will be kept inside single sealed cover superscribed as "Tender for Bulk Purchase of Medicines" on its top.
- 2. The tenderers have to submit the following documents along with the tender paper in Technical Bid (Cover-A):
- a.Self Attested Xerox copy of up to date valid Drug License/Retention copy/Renewal copy.
- b. Self Attested Xerox copy of up to date GST Return Certificate.
- c. Self Attested Xerox copy of Pan Card.
- d. Self Attested Xerox copy of Registration Certificate registered under GST.
- e. Account payee DD worth Rs. 2,00,000.00 towards cost of EMD in favour of **Director**, **Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre**, **Cuttack** should be attached with the tender paper (Cover-A).
- f. Certificate in respect of yearly turnover of preceding 3 (three) successive years, i.e ,2022-23,2023-24,2024-25 which should not be less than Rs. 1 crore per annum.
- 3. Rs. 4000.00 (non-refundable) in shape of DD in favour of **Director, Acharya Harihar Regional Cancer Centre, Cuttack** should be attached with the tender paper (Cover-A) towards cost of tender paper.
- 4. Bidders participating in the tender must have minimum 3 (three) years experience of supplying both anticancer & general medicines & documents supporting (purchase orders) of last 3 years.
- 5. Valid purchase orders towards rate contract of medicines of not less than Rs. 50 lakhs total in the last financial year, i.e., during 2024-25 from any Govt. Hospital.

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. The tenderer should be a registered firm under GST.
- 2. The quoted rates should be exclusive of all taxes and HSN code should be mentioned against each quoted item.
- 3. The delivery should be at the Technical sub-store of this hospital in full and good condition.
- 4. Any conditional tender will not be accepted.
- 5. No advance payment will be made against execution of order. The required items are to be procured on credit basis against different orders, and payment will be made on submission of bills in triplicate to the undersigned. The authority will not be liable for any delay in payment in unavoidable circumstance like paucity of funds, etc.
- 6. The rates quoted shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of finalization of the tender.
- 7. Selection of items may be followed by selection of samples as per given specification whenever necessary
- 8. The tenderers shall depute a technical person for demonstration of tender items with specification before the members of the selection committee wherever necessary.
- 9. As this is a tertiary cancer care hospital ,these items will be required on emergency basis. The supplier should supply the items as far as possible after the issue of the purchase order taking into the patient care service.
- 10. The bidder should have their supplying branch office in the Cuttack or Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation Area to meet the emergency requirement of the hospital. The detailed address and phone number should be mentioned.
- 11. The successful bidders will be required to furnish a performance security deposit of Rs.5Lakh. Only in the Form of DD in the name of The Director, AcharyaHarihar Regional cancer center, Cuttack.
  Security Diposit is liable to be forfeited if the bidder widhdraws or impairs or derogates the bid in any respect.
- 12. Tenderers qualified after opening of the technical bid shall be called for opening of price bid of the tender, the date and time of which shall be intimated in due course.
- 13. No tender beyond the stipulated date & time will be accepted, and Tenders without EMD and tender paper cost will not be considered.
- 14. EMD of the successful bidder shall remain with the undersigned till expiry of valid period of the tender, and the EMD of unsuccessful tenderers will be returned after finalization of the tender process.
- 15. Original documents shall be produced for verification if asked for.
- 16. If any information/documents furnished by the tenderers with the tender paper are found to be misleading or incorrect at any stage, their tenders will be cancelled and the said tenderers shall be barred from taking part in any further tender process in subsequent years.
- 17. Either the tenderer or his/her authorized representative may remain present at the time of opening of the tenders. However, their absence shall not be a bar for opening of tenders.
- 18. Tender items are to be quoted in price per unit (per capsule/tablet/vial/ample).
- 19. Valid WHO GMP Certificate of the manufacturer of a particular drug must be enclosed while supplying/quoting the drugs.
- 20. Affidavit sworn before the Executive Magistrate must be submitted by the tenderer certifying the product/drug to be true and genuine and from original manufacturing company/firm.

- 21. Certificate regarding Annual turnover of 3 preceding years, which should be not less than Rs. 1 crore shall be submitted with the tender documents.
- 22. The selected tenderer shall not discontinue supply during the contract period under any circumstances. Otherwise, the EMD will be forfeited and legal action as deemed proper shall be intiated against the selected tenderer.
- 23. The validity of the tender will remain in force for a period of one year from the date of approval, and on satisfactory performance by the party, it may be extended for another one year at the sole discretion of the authority.
- 24. The qualified bidder shall sign a MOU/Agreement with the authority as per the said terms and conditions and anything more as decided by the authority may be included within the same.
- 25. The undersigned reserves the full right to accept in full or part or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
- 26. The medicines supplied by the successful bidder should have a minimum of six months of expiry self life period from the date of supply. An undertaking in this regard in the bidder's letterhead must be submitted with the technical bid.

27. If the product is found unsuitable for use after the receipt of the items, the same will be replaced by the supply firm.
